Dear Residents and Employees,

There are currently no cases of COVID-19 in any resident. There is one new positive case for a Waverly Care employee, who was working on campus in Independent Living. This person was asymptomatic and received a positive test result yesterday during our routine testing of staff. This person is recovering well and is quarantining at home. Close contacts have been identified, who were fully vaccinated, and all have been tested for COVID-19. These test results have been received, and results were negative. Again, the proper and consistent wearing of face masks at all times, frequent hand washing and being vaccinated are key contributors to successful outcomes.

The Montgomery County 14-day positivity rate as of Sunday, April 24th reflected a slight decrease to 7.48%. The Main Line Health system COVID-19 related admissions to their four hospitals and one acute rehabilitation center are about 80 inpatients.

Another vaccine clinic was held this past Tuesday where ten people received their second dose of the Pfizer vaccine. The percentage of vaccinated residents remains 99.5% with one Independent Living and one Personal Care resident choosing not to receive the vaccine. The percentage of vaccinated employees is 79% for Waverly Heights and 86% for Waverly Care. We will continue to conduct weekly tests of non-vaccinated employees to ensure quick identification of any positive cases.
