Dear Residents and Employees,

We are providing this weekly update to let you know that our one resident case of COVID-19 that had been identified in the Personal Care area continues to resolve. The individual is currently in our special COVID-19 area in Muirfield where they are finishing their quarantine period.

Under the guidance from the Department of Human Services, Windsor and Devonshire will continue to be closed to visitors except in the case of compassionate care visits until next Friday, June 18th. The dining venues and group activities in Personal Care will also continue to be closed until Friday, June 18th. Any resident from Independent Living who would like to visit someone in Muirfield is asked to access it using the outside main entrance to that area.

As previously communicated, all Independent Living visitors must wear face masks when in the Carlton Commons areas, except when actively dining/drinking, regardless of vaccination status. Guests must continue to check-in at the wellness kiosks when visiting campus. **Residents are strongly encouraged to only invite vaccinated individuals to visit our community at this time. Since children under age 12 are not yet vaccinated, we continue to recommend that they do not visit campus.**

Finally, the Montgomery County Positivity rate is now down to 2.02% as of Thursday, June 2nd. The Main Line Health System reports just three COVID-19 inpatients across their entire system. The vaccine is working and we must continue to encourage everyone to get vaccinated.
