Dear Residents and Employees,

With the terrific news that the Moderna and Johnson & Johnson booster shots have been formally approved by the FDA and the CDC, we can now conduct a vaccination clinic for individuals who received those brands of the COVID-19 vaccine. The Moderna booster was approved to be administered six months after your second dose and for half of the dosage.

Our resident booster clinic with Eric's Pharmacy will be at Waverly Heights on Wednesday, November 3rd at 10:00 AM in the Auditorium. The employee booster clinic will be held on Wednesday, November 10th at 10:00 AM in the Auditorium. A representative from our team in the Health Care Center will contact each resident prior to the clinic to answer any questions. Employees should begin contacting Laura Santangelo at extension #8742 to register for the upcoming clinic.

There are currently no residents or employees who are positive for COVID-19. Montgomery County's positivity rate was updated as of Friday, October 15th at 5.54%. This past Tuesday, Main Line Health reported 37 inpatients between their four acute care hospitals with 33% of those being "breakthrough" cases of fully vaccinated individuals. We ask that you please continue to be vigilant at wearing a mask properly, maintaining social distance and frequently wash hands. Again, we strongly recommend that you only visit with fully vaccinated individuals and refrain from having children under the age of 12 on campus until the positivity rate in the outside community declines to a less significant level.
