Upon conclusion of our latest round of surveillance testing, there are currently no employees or residents of the Health Care Center actively positive with COVID-19. All employees continue to wear appropriate personal protective equipment the entire time they are at work, providing a layer of protection that significantly reduces the possibility of any spread. We anticipate the resumption of communal dining and small group programming in Muirfield and Personal Care starting Monday, January 31<sup>st</sup>.

Our Medical Director, Dr. Charlie Breish, continues to be actively involved and oversee the medical care protocols for this evolving situation. We continue to follow the current testing and restriction guidelines from all appropriate governing bodies for Skilled Nursing and Personal Care.

We ask that any visitors carefully consider limiting the number of guests present at one time and the duration of their visit, and remain properly masked at all times. Visitors should not enter the building if they are experiencing any signs or symptoms of infection, or have had exposure to the virus in the past 14 days.
