Dear Residents and Employees,

There are currently no cases of COVID-19 within the Waverly Heights Community. As of the most recent update from Montgomery County, the positivity rate has decreased to just over 17%.

Beginning next week, we will resume larger group programming and activities in Independent Living. In the coming weeks we will begin utilizing the Auditorium and The Bates Family Theatre for a variety of events. We will continue to limit capacity based upon our ability to social distance, but these capacities will be higher than the maximum of ten under which we have been operating. In the meantime, please refer to the bulletin boards outside of Resident Services' offices for sign-up sheets and also on *Touchtown/MyWaverlyApp* for further updates. A **revised** February calendar has also been distributed to the in-house mailboxes. In addition, we are pleased that the Health Care Center has resumed full group dining and programming for all residents.

Our booster mandate for all employees of Waverly Heights and Waverly Care has resulted in nearly 99% of all staff receiving the booster to supplement their initial vaccination. We would like to thank our team of dedicated employees for their commitment to providing a safe environment for their co-workers, our residents, and clients. It is truly a remarkable accomplishment that nearly every one of our residents and employees are fully vaccinated including boosters. You have made the difference and we are all grateful for your commitment.
