Dear Residents and Employees,

There continue to be no cases of COVID-19 within the Waverly Heights Community. As of the most recent update from Montgomery County, the positivity rate has decreased to about 9%.

With our extremely high resident and employee vaccination rate, which includes boosters, combined with a declining Montgomery County positivity rate, our plan is to resume full capacity for all programs throughout Waverly Heights as of March 1st. We are also evaluating the Carlton Commons masking requirement and may eliminate this requirement in the near future. Visitors are still required to check-in at the front desk and to be fully vaccinated to enter the Carlton Commons. Anyone entering the Health Care Center is also required to check-in and will be required to continue wearing a facemask for the foreseeable future.

We are pleased that our community is continuing to do well during the pandemic. We certainly welcome the return of our many programs, amenities, and services that enhance the lives of our residents and employees.
