Dear Residents and Employees,

We first want to express our thoughts and support for any residents, employees, family members or friends impacted by the crisis in Ukraine. Waverly Heights has a variety of supportive resources available to assist our residents and employees, please do not hesitate to reach out to either Brenda McFadden (x8841) or Lauren Kelley (x8610) if you need any resources. In addition, The United Ukrainian American Relief Committee has a website at www.uuarc.org with current information about the needs and situation in their country.

As the pandemic-related issues continue to improve across the country, we have seen the ongoing decline in the Montgomery County positivity rate. The most current information from the CDC shows the fourteen-day rate now at 3.34% as of March 7th. There continue to be no cases of COVID-19 identified for any resident or employee of Waverly Heights, and it has been nearly 25 days since the last positive case within our community.

As a reminder, the following guidelines become effective on Friday, March 11th:

- Facemasks for residents and guests will be optional in the Carlton Commons public spaces and all areas of residential living.
- During large, seated group programs in the Auditorium and Bates Family Theatre, such as Forums, movies, and lectures, we ask that residents wear a facemask during the program.
- Please note: Facemasks must continue to be worn when residents, employees, families or visitors enter the Health Care Center, Rehabilitation Therapy, Pharmacy area and Wellness Offices.
- Employees continue to be required to wear facemasks in all areas.
- Guests continue to be required to check-in and complete the wellness screening questionnaire at the kiosks.
- Guests to the Carlton Commons areas must be fully vaccinated. Our front desk staff will continue to review visitors' proof of vaccination at time of entry and check-in.

We will continue to provide updated guidance as appropriate. Thank you for your continued support in our efforts to return to normal operations in a post-pandemic environment.
