Due to a reported family exposure, testing was conducted on a resident of Personal Care and we have learned this morning that this resident has tested positive. This individual is asymptomatic and is doing well. Per our protocols, this individual has been quarantined since we learned of their exposure and they will remain in quarantine in accordance with state guidelines and under the direction of our Medical Director.

Any direct contacts have been notified and will be monitored for any signs and symptoms associated with the virus.

Our Medical Director, Dr. Charlie Breish, continues to be involved and overseeing the medical care protocols for this situation. We continue to follow the current testing and restriction guidelines from all appropriate governing bodies for Skilled Nursing and Personal Care.

Residents are being closely monitored by our staff on an ongoing basis for any signs or symptoms. We are urging everyone to closely monitor themselves for any signs of illness and we continue to ask you not visit if you have been exposed or you are experiencing any symptoms.
