**SUBJECT: COVID-19 (Coronavirus) Update**

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We are glad to report that the Personal Care resident who recently tested positive has concluded their quarantine and is doing very well.

Unfortunately, we have learned this morning that a staff member and a resident of Personal Care have tested positive for COVID-19. The resident is experiencing very mild symptoms and is otherwise doing well. Per our protocols, this resident has been quarantined since mild symptoms were observed and they will remain in quarantine in accordance with state guidelines and under the direction of our Medical Director. The staff member who tested positive is not experiencing any symptoms and last worked on Friday, May 6<sup>th</sup>. This employee is quarantining at home.

Any direct contacts have been notified and will be monitored for any signs and symptoms associated with the virus.

Our Medical Director, Dr. Charlie Breish, continues to be involved and overseeing the medical care protocols for this situation. We continue to follow the current testing and restriction guidelines from all appropriate governing bodies for Skilled Nursing and Personal Care.

Residents are being closely monitored by our staff on an ongoing basis for any signs or symptoms. We are urging everyone to closely monitor themselves for any signs of illness and we continue to ask you not visit if you have been exposed or you are experiencing any symptoms.
