Dear Residents and Employees,

We would like to recognize and thank those who have served our country and especially to those who made the ultimate sacrifice to protect our freedom. Please have a happy and safe Memorial Day weekend.

The county positivity rate on the Department of Health website is now at 19.2%. Waverly Heights currently has two residents in Independent Living and one in Windsor who are positive for COVID-19. There are also two Waverly Heights and two Waverly Care employees with positive results. The good news is that we are consistently seeing just mild to moderate cases and none of those infected have been hospitalized.

With the high positivity rates in Montgomery County and the moderate increase in cases at Waverly Heights, we are implementing our mandatory face masking policy in the Carlton Commons area. Face masks will now be required for everyone with the only exception being while eating/drinking in the dining venues. We also continue to strongly recommend that you wear a face mask when going off campus into public spaces. Face masks are available at the front desk.

We will continue to provide updated guidance as appropriate and hope that this action will serve as a proactive approach to having the virus spread within our community.
