This morning we obtained results of a Muirfield resident who has tested positive with COVID-19. The resident was experiencing mild symptoms and has been quarantining since symptoms were identified and the test was obtained. The resident will remain in quarantine for the designated time period in accordance with state and federal guidelines. The resident is doing well at this time.

Any direct contacts have been notified and will be monitored for any signs and symptoms associated with the virus. Our Medical Director, Dr. Charlie Breish, is involved and overseeing the medical care protocols for this situation. We continue to follow the current testing and restriction guidelines from all appropriate governing bodies for Skilled Nursing.

Residents and staff are being closely monitored on an on-going basis for any signs or symptoms. We are urging everyone to closely monitor themselves for any signs of illness and we continue to ask you not visit if you have been exposed or you are experiencing any symptoms.
