SUBJECT: COVID-19 (Coronavirus) Update

Through our ongoing surveillance testing, we learned today that three Health Care Center employees have tested positive for COVID-19. The employees are all doing well and experiencing mild or no symptoms. There have been no new resident cases identified. At this time, we currently have two residents in Muirfield and one resident in the hospital positive for COVID-19. There are currently no positive residents in Windsor or Devonshire.

Any direct contacts have been notified and will be monitored for any signs and symptoms associated with the virus. Our Medical Director, Dr. Charlie Breish, is involved and overseeing the medical care protocols for this situation. We continue to follow the current testing and restriction guidelines from all appropriate governing bodies for Skilled Nursing and Personal Care.

Residents and staff are being closely monitored on an on-going basis for any signs or symptoms. We are urging everyone to closely monitor themselves for any signs of illness and we continue to ask you not visit if you have been exposed or you are experiencing any symptoms.
