Today a resident of Personal Care who was identified as COVID-positive in the hospital has returned to Waverly Heights. This resident is experiencing mild symptoms and will remain in quarantine for the required time period in accordance with state and federal guidelines. At this time, we currently have two residents and zero employees in Personal Care positive for COVID-19.

Any direct contacts have been notified and will be monitored for any signs and symptoms associated with the virus. Our Medical Director, Dr. Charlie Breish, is involved and overseeing the medical care protocols for this situation. We continue to follow the current testing and restriction guidelines from all appropriate governing bodies for Skilled Nursing and Personal Care.

Residents and staff are being closely monitored on an ongoing basis for any signs or symptoms. We are urging everyone to closely monitor themselves for any signs of illness and we continue to ask you not visit if you have been exposed or you are experiencing any symptoms.
