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Yesterday a resident who was admitted to the hospital for a non-COVID related diagnosis but subsequently tested positive was admitted to Muirfield. This resident is asymptomatic and will remain in quarantine for the required time period in accordance with state and federal guidelines. At this time, we currently have one resident and zero employees in Muirfield positive for COVID-19.

Any direct contacts have been notified and will be monitored for any signs and symptoms associated with the virus. Our Medical Director, Dr. Charlie Breish, is involved and overseeing the medical care protocols for this situation. We continue to follow the current testing and restriction guidelines from all appropriate governing bodies for Skilled Nursing.

Residents and staff are being closely monitored on an on-going basis for any signs or symptoms. We are urging everyone to closely monitor themselves for any signs of illness and we continue to ask you not visit if you have been exposed or you are experiencing any symptoms.
