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Today we learned that a staff member of Personal Care tested positive for COVID-19. The staff member who tested positive last worked on Thursday, October 27<sup>th</sup> and is experiencing mild symptoms. Per our protocols, this employee will remain in quarantine for the designated time period in accordance with state and federal guidelines.

Any direct contacts have been notified and will be monitored for any signs and symptoms associated with the virus.

Our Medical Director, Dr. Charlie Breish, continues to be involved and overseeing the medical care protocols for this situation. We continue to follow the current testing and restriction guidelines from all appropriate governing bodies for Personal Care.

Residents are being closely monitored by our staff on an ongoing basis for any signs or symptoms. We are urging everyone to closely monitor themselves for any signs of illness and we continue to ask you not visit if you have been exposed or you are experiencing any symptoms.
